Stalls are assigned and will be posted at 3pm on Friday.

You will be asked to move if you are not in your assigned stall.

No one is allowed to enter the barns until 3pm on Friday.

Cancellations must be made by Wednesday 9pm prior to the show.

Stalls are \$35 each, a \$5 refund will be made for each stall that is completely Cleaned out and the bedding dumped into the designated trailer to be hauled away.

The following is a summary of Park & Recreation rules:

- The grounds will be opened on the day before the show at 3:00 and after.
- No one will be allowed to park behind the barns or the concession stand in the fire lane. Your vehicle will be towed if it is parked there!
- No one is allowed to enter the barns until 3:00 the day before the show. If you arrive earlier, you cannot unload and must wait in the approved horse trailer parking area in the west side of the parking lot.
- All trailers must be parked in the west lot off the blacktop unless your trailer is used as a camper. If you park your trailer in the camping area, you will be charged \$25 per day.
- As soon as you unload, you must move your trailers--there are no exceptions. Parks and Rec. will have your vehicle towed.
- Horses are to stay off the pavement except at the Horse Crossing and in the lanes to the barns from the arena. They CANNOT stand on the pavement at the top of the hill, at the concession stand etc.
- Horses cannot be ridden up and down the hill nor to and from the parking lot.
- Horses **MUST** cross from the lot at the Horse Crossing near the entrance to the park, walking behind the Red Barn to the arenas.
